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Basis for Intervening:

ODEC is a not-for-profit power supply electric cooperative, organized and operating under the laws of Virginia and subject to FERC jurisdiction. ODEC supplies capacity and energy to its eleven electric distribution cooperative members, all of which are located within the PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (â€œPJMâ€) control area. ODEC is a network transmission customer of PJM, as well as a PJM Transmission Owner. ODEC is a generation-owning utility, dependent upon the use of the transmission facilities of PJM under its Tariff to deliver the output of ODECâ€™s generation facilities located within PJM and to deliver periodic power purchases from third party sellers to the load of its member systems in PJMâ€™s footprint. ODEC takes transmission service under the PJM Tariff. ODEC is also a Market Seller of energy and capacity under the PJM Tariff. As such, ODEC stands to be directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding and no other party can adequately represent ODECâ€™s interests.
