Basis for Intervening:

In this proceeding, Complainant asks the Commission to direct the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) to take certain actions concerning use of Chinese equipment or systems in the Bulk Power System.

The American Public Power Association (APPA) is the national service organization representing the interests of not-for-profit, state, municipal and other locally owned electric utilities in the United States. More than 2,000 public power utilities, doing business in every state but Hawaii, account for over 15 percent of all electric energy (kilowatt-hours) sales to ultimate consumers in the nation and collectively serve 49 million consumers. The primary goal of these public power utilities is providing customers in the communities they serve with reliable electric power and energy at the lowest reasonable cost. This orientation aligns the interests of public power utilities with the long-term interests of the residents and businesses in their communities.

APPA has electric utility members that are subject to NERC mandatory reliability standards. The outcome of this proceeding could directly affect these members, as well as other APPA electric utility members. APPA wishes to intervene in this proceeding to represent the interests of its members as such interests may arise. APPA submits that its participation in this proceeding is in the public interest. Accordingly, APPA respectfully moves to intervene in this proceeding.
